

APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR VARIOUS ISS AWARDS

Sugandhasree Innovative Farmer Award

The award which is given away biannually is instituted to recognize farmer's innovation in spices crops for enhanced income with sustainability in India. The award carries a citation and cash prize of Rs. 5,000/-. Any farmer who has been actively involved himself/herself in spices cultivation would be considered for the award.

Individuals who are interested to apply for the award are required to send their applications highlighting the significance and contribution to the field of spices research. The nomination should be sent through the concerned State Agricultural University/ICAR Institutes/Spices Board/State Agricultural/Horticultural Departments certifying the authenticity of the innovation.

The application submitted would be judged by a panel of experts whose recommendations would be considered by the executive committee for the award which would be final.

The award would be presented at the General Body Meeting of the Society.

Fellow – ISS

Eligibility and procedure for selection

1. Fellows will be selected from among those who have been Life Members of Indian Society for Spices (ISS) for a minimum of 5 years and have made significant contribution to the cause of spices.
2. Life member of ISS shall forward nominations for future fellows in the prescribed proforma with supportive evidences. Fellows will be inducted after evaluation of their significant contributions in spices research and development.
3. A life member can propose a single nominee and second another nominee in a year.
4. A maximum of five Fellows will be inducted in a year.
5. Executive Council of ISS will constitute a committee of minimum of three fellows to evaluate the contributions of the nominees as per the guidelines prescribed by the Executive Council of ISS.

Dr. VS Korikanthimath Award for the Best Ph.D. Thesis on Spices, Medicinal and Aromatic Crops

The award which is given biennially is instituted to motivate high quality fundamental and applied research amongst Ph.D. scholars in India, in the field of spices. The award is open to all Indian students and carries a citation and medal. Theses for which final viva-voce is completed during the biennial period would be considered for the award.

Individuals who are interested to apply for the award are required to send their applications along with a copy of thesis submitted by them for their Ph.D. degree during January 2015 to December 2016, together with 5 copies of synopsis, highlighting the significance and contribution to the field of spices research. The nomination should be accompanied by a certificate from the concerned Advisor/Guide/Head of the Department where the study was conducted certifying the authenticity of the study.

The thesis submitted would be judged by a panel of experts whose recommendations would be considered by the executive committee for the award which would be final.

The award would be presented at the General Body Meeting of the Society and the recipient of the award should deliver an illustrated talk based on his/her significant research work submitted for the award. TA/DA (restricted to 3 AC) shall be paid to the recipient of the award for his/her journey from his/her place of work to the place where the award function is being held.

Smt. Vijaya V. Korikanthimath Best M.Sc. Thesis Award on Spices, Medicinal and Aromatic Crops

The award which is given biennially is instituted to motivate high quality fundamental and applied research amongst M.Sc. scholars in India, in the field of spices. The award is open to all Indian students and carries a citation and medal. Theses for which final viva-voce is completed during the biennial period would be considered for the award.

Individuals who are interested to apply for the award are required to send their applications along with a copy of thesis submitted by them for their M.Sc. degree during January 2015 to December 2016, together with 5 copies of synopsis, highlighting the significance and contribution to the field of spices research. The nomination should be accompanied by a certificate from the concerned Advisor/Guide/ Head of the Department where the study was conducted certifying the authenticity of the study.

The thesis submitted would be judged by a panel of experts whose recommendations would be considered by the executive committee for the award which would be final.

The award would be presented at the General Body Meeting of the Society. TA/DA (restricted to 3 AC) shall be paid to the recipient of the award for his/her journey from his/her place of work to the place where the award function is being held.
